This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students from Prep to Year 6 achieving at or above regional benchmarks in reading to 90% by the end of 2022
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English and Maths to 50% in all year levels

Our initiatives include

- Employing additional teacher aides to support student learning during highly structured, differentiated reading blocks across all year levels
- Increasing teacher aide allocation to support inclusivity across the whole school and to support intervention programs
- Continuing to build staff capability in "best practice" through ongoing Professional Development and Mentoring programs, particularly in reading
